Come spring, Notting Hill's Hereford Road is a sea of bouffant pink cherry blossom, which accessorises rather beautifully with the green-and-white-striped awnings of the Princess Royal. It's a magnificent Victorian boozer that was reborn last year as a posh restaurant with rooms. Lobsters and oysters are piled high on the raw bar, while the chef Ben Tish's main menu matches English burrata with harissa-spiced quince, and Dorset monkfish with chilli and salsa verde. Upstairs in the four bedrooms indulgence comes in the shape of free-standing baths, piles of magazines and a selection of books that will inspire you to get out and about in west London.
