The Unruly Pig, Woodbridge

Let's Pig Out

One of the most keenly contested awards this year, the Best Pub category had the judges fiercely debating these unmissable locals. However, the multi-award-winning Unruly Pig – also named Estrella Damm's UK gastropub of the year in 2022 – ticked every perfect-pub box. A 16th-century coaching inn in rural Suffolk, it features log burners and period oak beams, but injects the old-school setting with modern vibes, delicious comfort food and next-level service. Handling rates the “beautiful location, relaxed venue and food you genuinely want to eat.” Other judges were equally blown away. “The menu is familiar enough for a British pub, but offers something a little different, with Italian influences seen throughout,” Monica Galetti says. “Plus, they have a great [roast](#) on Sundays – essential for any pub.” theunrulypig.co.uk
